Re: TRAUMA TECH TEMPORARY CLOSURE DUE TO COVID-19

With growing global concerns around COVID-19 (“coronavirus”), I wanted to provide you with an update on our response to date and our commitment to you moving forward.

The health, safety and well-being of our staff, instructors and students is Trauma Tech’s top priority and we have been following the lead of British Columbia public health authorities at this important time. Unfortunately, as things have progressed, we have decided to temporarily postpone all training to help limit the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

Beginning on March 21st, 2020, no classes will be held at any of our Trauma Tech facilities. Currently, our plan is to re-open on April 5th, 2020. However, the situation is changing quickly, and we will be reevaluating that decision on a day-to-day basis.

Our office staff will be contacting every student that is currently registered for classes in the next two weeks. Obviously, these registrations will be rescheduled at no additional cost.

Again, we continue to monitor this situation closely and will provide ongoing updates as needed.
